1	1	Wheel chock

⚠ WARNING

Effective wheel chock use is application-specific based on placement, wheel size, grade, ground / surface conditions and vehicle weight. The end user is responsible for validating the chock is acceptable for their specific application. Improper use may result in property damage, serious injury or death.

Do not use wheel chocks if there are any visual signs of damage. Damaged wheel chocks may not work effectively, resulting in property damage, serious injury or death.

Wheel chocks should always be used in pairs.
Multiple pairs may be required in extreme situations.

Chocks should always be applied on the downhill side of the tires.

When a vehicle is on a level grade, chocks should be used in the front and rear of the tires.

Chocks must always be installed flush and centered on the tires to function effectively.

Always ensure the parking brake is applied and functioning prior to installing wheel chocks.
