USER SAFETY CAUTION

During installation, be mindful of the potential for sharp edges on the product or vehicle. Taking proper safety precautions helps ensure a safe and smooth installation process.



Always wear protective gloves and handle components with care to reduce the risk of injury.

TEMPERATURE SURFACE CAUTION

During high temperatures or extended sun exposure, surfaces of this product may become hot to the touch, posing a risk of burns or injury. Use caution when handling the product in hot weather and allow time for it to cool before contact.



Always check surface temperature before use to ensure safe handling conditions.

FASTENER TORQUE CAUTION

All fasteners must be tightened to the specified torque values provided in the installation instructions to ensure proper fit and safe operation of the tonneau cover. Under- or over-tightening can lead to product failure, potential damage to your vehicle, injury, or safety hazards while driving.



Always use a calibrated torque wrench and follow the specifications in the installation instructions.

PINCH POINT SAFETY CAUTION

This tonneau cover may create pinch points when closing or operating near solid surfaces such as the truck bed rails or tailgate. To prevent injury, keep hands, fingers, and other body parts clear of moving parts during operation.



Always operate the cover slowly and with caution to ensure safe and proper use.

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ENTRAPMENT SAFETY WARNING

This tonneau cover does not feature a manual release mechanism from inside the truck bed. To prevent the risk of entrapment, never allow anyone to be inside the bed of the truck when the cover is closed.



Always ensure the area is clear before closing the cover, and keep the cover securely latched when not in use to avoid accidental closure.

COVER ATTACHMENT WARNING

A partially folded up or unsecured cover may detach during transit, risking vehicle or property damage and personal injury.



Always verify the tonneau cover is properly secured before operating the vehicle.

CARGO TRANSPORT WARNING

When transporting cargo that is taller than the truck bed, the cover must be fully folded open and securely fastened with both retainer straps. An unsecured cover can detach while driving, risking vehicle or property damage and personal injury.



Never operate the vehicle with a partially folded up cover.

COVER POSITION WARNING

Before operating the vehicle, always verify the tonneau cover is either fully folded open and secured with both buckles or fully folded closed and securely latched down.



Never operate the vehicle if the tonneau cover is not properly secured.




NOTE: It is important that all areas where the bed cover mounts are clean and free of debris prior to installing.


- A** Cover assembly

1 Remove the 4 upper tie-down hooks. Keep the 8 Torx screws, but do **not** reuse the tie-down hooks.




Front, upper tie-down hooks.
Both sides.




Rear, upper tie-down hooks.
Both sides.


2 Align the parts for assembly as shown.




- 3** Slide two of the rail brackets (D) into each rail (B & C). Align with the rail interior profile as shown.



- 4** Slide one rail bracket (D) towards the cab, leaving the other at the tailgate of each rail (B & C).




- 5** With the rail brackets (D) slid into the rails (B & C), assemble the full brackets as shown. Loosely tighten the screws (G) with provided 3/16" hex wrench.




- 6** Place the rails (B & C) on the truck once the brackets are mounted to the rails. Position the rails (B & C) so the front cap pad firmly contacts the bulkhead. Align the brackets so they line up with the factory tie-down hook bolt holes, then thread in the Torx screws from Step 1 and tighten.

Tighten the front hardware while pushing down on the rail to make a good seal contact with the truck bed while at the same time also push the rail forward to keep good contact between the cap pad and bulkhead. Continue to push down on the rail while tightening the rear bracket hardware.


Tighten both Torx screws, then tighten both Allen head bolts with the provided T-50 Torx wrench to **8 ft-lbs (10.8 Nm)**.



Rail must align against bedcap for proper sealing and to prevent obstruction with in-bed trunk lid.






Cap pad to bulkhead


7 Place the folded cover (A) on the cab end of the truck bed. Make sure the cover is square with the truck bed and the bulkhead seal sits on the truck bed bulkhead.




8 Unfold the bed cover (A) fully and adjust position over the truck bed for proper front (cab) and rear (tailgate) alignment. When positioned front and back, the tailgate seal should contact the tailgate with the first two fins.




9 Carefully refold the bed cover (A) without shifting its position on the truck bed.




10 Hook the jaw of the cab clamps under the edge of the mounting rails (B & C). Tighten the knobs until the jaw contacts the rails (B & C), then tighten an additional two turns. Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed. **Do NOT use a wrench or overtighten!**




11 At the tailgate attach the striker brackets (J) to the mounting rails (B & C) by threading the screws (L) through the striker bracket (J), through the rail (B & C) and into the slide block (K).



12 Install the striker brackets (J) on both sides of the truck. Leave the screws (L) loose for later adjustments.




13 Close the bed cover (A), align the latch with the striker bracket (J) and hand tighten the screws (L) with a Phillips screwdriver. Push down on the cover (A) while tightening. Repeat on the opposite side of the truck bed.



14 Adjustments and tightening of the latch assembly is required.


The bed cover latch assemblies and rotary knob come from the factory only partially tightened to allow for installation adjustments. Both latches and rotary knob will require adjustment and final tightening. **Only use the hand tools provided, do not use power tools.**



Lower the rear of the bed cover and adjust the position of each latch so that they engage with the striker brackets, (Fig. 1). With the latches adjusted, from underneath the cover, use the provided T-20 Torx wrench to tighten the two screws, (Fig. 2) so the latch does not move in the channel. Repeat on the other side.



The cable from the driver's side latch comes routed through the barrel clamp of the actuator and hangs out. Slide the actuator so that 3/4" - 1" (19.1 - 25.4mm) of cable extends through the barrel clamp, (Fig. 3).

Rotate the actuator knob until you see the flat head screws. Tighten the two flat head screws using the provided T20 hex wrench, (Fig. 3). So the latch does not move in the channel. Repeat on the other side.




The cable from the passenger side latch comes routed through the other barrel clamp of the actuator. Excess cable length is routed through the middle of the actuator assembly (above the bottom plate below the plastic housing). Do not trim the excess cable, leave it for future adjustments, (Fig. 3).

Next, tighten the barrel clamps, (Fig. 4) with the provided 2.5mm hex key to secure the latch cables. Rotate the actuator knob, (Fig. 4) to verify that the latches disengage from the striker brackets.




Double-check that the cover is secure and tight to the truck bed by gently lifting the corners to ensure the mechanisms are engaged.

15 To make the final adjustment, loosen the striker bracket screws. Then move the bracket down by firmly pulling the cover to the truck rail and tailgate. Make sure that both sides match, then re-tighten the screws to **6 ft-lbs (8.1 Nm)**.




16 The tethers come installed looped over the bed cover bow with a snap hook at the other end. Hook the tether onto the truck bed tie-down. Install the tethers on both sides of the cover.





Opening the cover

Open the cover by twisting the actuator knob and lifting the cover.



Securing the cover

To drive with the cover open, fold the cover forward to the cab and fasten BOTH straps in the middle section to the front rail. Check that the straps are tight, and pull the strap end if too loose.




! IMPORTANT

Re-tighten the front/cab clamps and tethers after the first week of driving the vehicle. Also periodically check the clamps and tethers to ensure they are secure.

Closed/Extended Position – Bed cover must be completely secured by all four (4) clamps.

Open/Folded Position – Bed cover must be completely folded up (all panels) and secured at the cab with the provided buckles straps and with both tethers attached.

Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position.



Do NOT allow the vehicle to be towed backwards without first removing the cover from the vehicle.




Remove any snow or foreign matter before folding the bed cover.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

The cover, including as applicable any hardware kit (e.g., rails, clamps, and bows) and fabric, carries a limited lifetime warranty. This limited warranty is subject to the following terms:

WARRANTY COVERAGE

This tonneau cover is warranted against defects in materials or workmanship. This warranty is void if the product has been damaged in an accident, or due to neglect, unforeseeable use, improper installation, improper servicing, or other cause not arising out of defects in material or workmanship.

WARRANTY IS NOT TRANSFERABLE

The warranty is to the initial owner purchasing the tonneau cover and it is not transferrable to a subsequent end user. Proof of purchase may be required to enforce the warranty rights.

WARRANTY CONDITIONS

Failure to follow these warnings and care instructions will void the warranty:

- Clean with mild automotive soap and water only.
- Do not use conditioners that contain silicone or petroleum.
- Tonneau cover must be secured at all points when vehicle is in motion. When not fully extended, cover must be completely folded up and secured at the cab with the provided buckle straps and tethers attached. Do NOT drive with the bed cover in a partially open position..
- Check front/cab clamps and retention mechanisms for tightness after a week of driving following installation (or re-installation) of the cover and periodically thereafter.
- Before opening, cover must be free of all foreign materials including snow and ice.
- To avoid potential damage to the cover, panel clamps/latches must be in their stored positions prior to opening/folding the panel.
- Do NOT tow your vehicle from the rear with the cover on your vehicle. If towing from the rear is required, the cover MUST be removed from the vehicle and properly stored.

WARRANTY PERFORMANCE

If all warranty conditions are met, a defective tonneau cover, tarp, or hardware component will either be repaired or replaced (at our option). We reserve the right, for any warranted return, to substitute a newer model of tonneau cover having similar form and function, to offer a warranty discount on an entire replacement system, and/or provide remedies other than those mentioned in this document.

WARRANTY PROCESS

A Return Authorization number must be obtained from our Customer Service Department prior to returning any product. We may require the original item to be returned postage prepaid for final determination. Shipping charges will apply for any repair or replacement. Other than postage or shipping charges, no charge will be made for repair or replacement under this warranty.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights. As an owner, you may also have additional rights and remedies under the laws of your state.

WARRANTY REGISTRATION

Warranty registration must be on file and/or proof of original purchase (detailed and dated receipt) required for warranty to be effective.
